For students participating in the Joint Admissions Program with SUNY College at Geneseo, maintaining continuous study, achieving a minimum 3.00 GPA, and successfully completing courses as specified in this advisement guide are required. If these conditions are not met, continued participation in this program and acceptance to SUNY College at Geneseo will be in jeopardy.
- 4. Students interested in teaching must submit a separate application to SUNY Geneseo's teacher certification program. Applications for admission to teacher certification programs are due Dec.1 for spring admission and April 15 for fall admission. Specific coursework and minimum 3.0 GPA are required for acceptance into the program. For additional information, go to http://education.geneseo.edu or SUNY Geneseo's catalog.
- 5. SUNY Geneseo requires students complete a minimum 15-hour experience working with children in a structured, academic setting in grades 7-12 prior to applying to the Adolescent Education program.
