Credit Hour Requirements

80 hours may come from Madisonville Community College

48 hours must come from a four-year school

3 hours Christian Studies course (to be offered in Madisonville by Mid-Continent)

33 hour core (general education that can come from Madisonville Community College)

48 hours Business Management (Advantage program) (This covers the residency requirement)

44 hours electives (to have 48 hours come from a four-year school, 5 of these hours must be four-year)

Transfer Advising

AA or AS Degree

If students come with an AA or AS degree, they have met all core requirements. The student will take a 3-hour Christian Studies course, the 48 Business Management hours and the remaining electives necessary to accumulate 128 total hours.

Without AA or AS Degree

If students come without AA or AS degree, they must be sure they have the core completed.

Then, the student will take a 3-hour Christian Studies class and their 48 BM hours plus 44 elective hours.

All Students

- Must have 2.0 CUM GPA to transfer. Mid-Continent does not include E's in that GPA.
- Mid-Continent does not accept D's in ENG 101 & 102.
- Mid-Continent only takes students age 24+, preferably with 2 years work experience.
- Mid-Continent does not take current Madisonville Community College students.
- Mid-Continent will accept whatever we say fulfills the core categories for an AA or AS degree.
- New groups typically start once or twice a year in Madisonville.
- Students will take all Mid-Continent classes here on the North campus.
