If these conditions are not met, continued participation in this program and acceptance to Keuka College will be in jeopardy.
3. FLCC students need to complete one 3 credit hour CSC course with a grade of "C" or better.
4. FLCC students need to complete MAT 121 AND MAT 122 with a grade of "C" or better in order for them to transfer to Keuka College.
