Associate in Applied Science (AAS), Associate in Science (AS) and Associate in Arts (AA) and
NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY (NKU)
Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership (OL)

GENERAL AGREEMENT

Transfer of credit is defined as a process for coordinating the linkage of postsecondary institutions within a community or across the state to help students make a smooth transition between institutions and from one program to another with limited duplication of courses. The Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership is designed as a degree completion program to extend the student's associate degree into a bachelor's degree.

Program of Study:

To participate in the provisions of this agreement, a KCTCS student will complete an AA, AS, or AAS degree and NKU agrees to accept that degree toward the requirements of the Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership program.

Students who complete an Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree will have completed all of the general education courses required for full general education certification. Students earning an Associate in Applied Science degree program will also need to complete the additional general education courses needed for full general education certification. Full general education certification is earned when a student completes an AA or AS degree at KCTCS, which includes 48 hours of general education courses as identified in Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education documents. KCTCS colleges will provide appropriate general education certification for students completing AA, AS, or AAS programs. Full general education certification does not necessarily guarantee that a student has satisfied all the prerequisite courses required for the OL program (see following list for required general education courses for OL program which **do** satisfy all the pre-requisites for the OL program).

The parties to this agreement are committed to an annual review of its details to adjust them for any relevant curricular changes at either institution. In the event of such changes, Northern Kentucky University will permit a KCTCS student covered under this agreement to designate a catalog year (for purposes of applicable requirements) up to two years before the matriculation date at Northern Kentucky University.

This transfer agreement will take effect upon the affixing of signatures of the Parties named below.

The agreement will be considered continuous until revision is requested by either party.

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BA in Organizational Leadership Transfer Agreement between NKU and KCTCS

The minimum requirements to earn the NKU Online Organizational Leadership degree that a student must complete are:

- 1. 48 hours of general education courses Kentucky General Education Transfer Frameworks block;
- 2. 35 hours (minimum) of any collegiate-level credit may include additional general education or elective credit; and
- 3. 45 hours of upper-level courses required for the major 300 level or above.

Writing/Accessing Information (6 hours)

REQUIRED: ENG 101 and ENG 102 or ENG 105

Students who complete ENG 105 must take an additional 3 hours from the general education core area.

Oral Communication (3 hours)

REQUIRED: COM 181

Heritage/Humanities (6 hours)

REQUIRED: One course in Humanities and one course in Heritage.

RECOMMENDED: HIS 108 or HIS 109

Social Interaction (9 hours)

REQUIRED: PSY 100 or PY 110. Two disciplines must be represented and be different than those in

Humanities, Heritage or Foreign Language. RECOMMENDED: ECO 201 and ECO 202

Science (6 hours)

At least one of the science courses must have a lab.

Mathematics (3 hours)

REQUIRED: Course must be College Algebra or a higher level MA course.

AREA OF CONCENTRATION (12 credits)

Students must complete a 12 credit hour concentration in a technology area or other specialized field (programs/courses offered by the College of Business are excluded) using 300-400 level coursework. For example, NKU offers a concentration in Web Development (online) that includes the following courses:

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERSHIP GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of 128 hours earned, 25% must be NKU coursework
- 45 semester hours of student's total program must be 300-400 level courses
- Students with an AAS degree must complete the required 48 hours in the General Education Block to receive Full Certification in General Education.
- Courses taken as Pass/Fail must be elective in nature and cannot be applicable to specific general education, major, minor or area of concentration requirements. Only 12 hours of pass/fail credits may count toward graduation.
