<b>History</b>  Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) of history.	<b>History</b>  HIST 1010 - 2260
<b>Humanities</b>  Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) with one course in the comparative study of the arts and the other selected from approved humanities courses.	<b>Humanities</b>  ARTS 1220, 1330; PHIL; MUSC 1050 - 1120; THEA 1090, 1130
<b>Literature</b>  One course (3 sem. hrs.) in literature.	<b>Literature</b>  ENGL 1020, 1030, 1040, 1200, 1210, 1220, 1230, 1240, 1250, 1260, 1270, 1280, 1290, 1360, 1370, 1430, 2020, 2030, 2040, 2200, 2230
<b>Social Science</b>  Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) in social science with courses selected from two different disciplines.	<b>Social Science</b>  POLS; PSYC; SOCS
<b>General Education Electives</b>  One course (3 sem. hrs.) selected from science, history, humanities, literature, mathematics, social science.	<b>General Education Electives</b>  May be completed by taking additional courses from the above categories, beyond the required number of courses
<b>Senior Seminar</b>  One course (3 sem. hrs.) in ethics, to be taken at Columbia as a capstone general education experience.	
<b>Total</b> 16 courses (48 sem. hrs.)
