Transfer Requirement Guide College: *Illinois Central* (AAS Degree)

The ASL-English Interpretation Department offers a core curriculum in American Sign Language, Deaf Culture, Interpreting, and Transliterating. In addition, students participate in an Interpreting Practicum and take a range of electives in psychology, sociology, and multicultural studies.

Transfer Admission Guidelines

Students completing the two-year Program at Illinois Central will receive core credit for the courses listed below within the ASL-English Interpretation Program at Columbia. Courses, which do not transfer as core credit, will fulfill elective credits toward the student's BA degree at Columbia.

Illinois Central students considering transferring to Columbia must visit Columbia and complete a language proficiency evaluation during their third semester at Illinois Central. Students who are prepared to enter the interpreting course at Columbia will not need to register for *Practicum* during the fourth semester at Illinois Central. The *Practicum* requirement will be waived for students who will be completing the BA requirements at Columbia College.
