

The Theater Department offers six concentrations to fulfill the Bachelor of Arts degree: Acting, Directing, Design, Technical Theater, Playwriting, and Musical Theater Performance. Additionally, the Theater Department offers three Bachelor of Fine Arts degrees: Acting, Directing, and Design. Guidelines are provided for the Bachelor of Arts degrees. Transfer students interested in pursuing a BFA should contact the Theater Department for guidelines and suggested programs.

Transfer Admission Guidelines

Columbia College accepts courses in transfer for both general education and major theater requirements. Students who take the following suggested theater courses and complete their Associate degree using Columbia equivalents can transfer to Columbia and begin a two-year concentration in theater.
