<u>Major Courses Bolded</u>: An overall GPA of 2.5 must be attained in **major** courses. <u>Graduation Unit Totals</u>: To graduate in four years, expect to take approximately 16 units per semester. A minimum of 126 units are needed.

\*All economics majors must pass MATH 170 COLLEGE ALGEBRA with a B or better. Remedial courses may be required. Please complete prior to freshman year.

\*\*Students may take their THEO course (3 units) during the summer between their Junior and Senior years instead of 18 units in Spring of their Junior year -It is important to take courses in order, as many are prerequisites to those that follow. If taken out of sequence, graduation in 4 years is not guaranteed -APU does not accept grades lower than a C- for transfer credit

-If remedial courses are needed, it is highly recommended they be completed prior to the freshman year (they are foundational for success in college level courses). -Note: remedial units will not transfer to APU, count towards minimum to transfer, or count towards the minimum required to graduate -Students need to transfer a minimum of 63 units in order to complete the economics degree in two years.
