<sup>\*</sup>All economics majors must pass MATH 170 COLLEGE ALGEBRA with a B or better. Remedial courses may be required. Please complete prior to freshman year.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Students may take their THEO course (3 units) during the summer between their Junior and Senior years instead of 18 units in Spring of their Junior year

<sup>-</sup>It is important to take courses in order, as many are prerequisites to those that follow. If taken out of sequence, graduation in 4 years is not guaranteed

<sup>-</sup>APU does not accept grades lower than a C- for transfer credit

<sup>-</sup>If remedial courses are needed, it is highly recommended they be completed prior to the freshman year (they are foundational for success in college level courses).

<sup>-</sup>Note: remedial units will not transfer to APU, count towards minimum to transfer, or count towards the minimum required to graduate

<sup>-</sup>Students need to transfer a minimum of 63 units in order to complete the economics degree in two years. Please refer to the APU catalog for further program information, admissions information, and the department requirements for the economics major--including admission to the School of Business
