TRANSFER EQUIVALENCY NOTES

All elective courses may be transferred from Central Michigan University if a grade of “C” or better has been earned. Subject matter for elective credit is at the discretion of the student. No coursework with a grade lower than “C” is acceptable for transfer credit.

Students who desire to transfer to the University of Detroit Mercy should contact the School of Architecture at the earliest possible time in order to facilitate the procedure for transfer. Generally, a “B” average is the criteria used for acceptance in the absence of other criteria. However, a grade point average approximating a “B” plus evidence of creative ability, is also considered. A portfolio of creative work, if available, should be submitted with the application.
