

MADONNA UNIVERSITY EQUIVALENCY GUIDE College of Engineering and Science ENGINEERING PROGRAMS

Entrance Requirements: 2.5 GPA based on at least 24 semester hours of credit.

The following courses will transfer into a University of Detroit Mercy Engineering program [Civil/Environmental, Electrical/Computer, Manufacturing or Mechanical]. Students may transfer a maximum of 96 semester hours of credit. According to transfer policy, additional courses not on this guide may also be transferable. Also, as members of the Detroit Area Catholic Higher Education Consortium, eligible Madonna University students may take a limited number of credits at UDM while paying their home institution's tuition rates. Consult with a UDM advisor regarding details.

UDM FAST FACTS

<u>US News and World Report Ranking</u> – For the fifth consecutive year, University of Detroit Mercy ranks in the top tier of Midwestern Master's Universities in the 2006 edition of the *U.S. News and World Report's* "America's Best Colleges." UDM is the top ranking Michigan university in this category. UDM is also rated number five in the Midwestern Master's category for the institution's strong "Campus Diversity."

<u>UDM is affordable!</u> Nearly 80% of UDM students receive some type of financial aid and/or scholarship. Combining co-op income and potential scholarships and financial aid, you may have little out-of-pocket expenses. <u>**Co-op Leader**</u> – For all engineering students at UDM, co-op integrates real engineering practice with a rigorous on-campus education that includes computing and laboratory intensive components. UDM has one of the few <u>four</u>-year engineering programs in the country where all students obtain one full year of experience prior to graduation. Besides valuable experience, students earn an average of nearly \$30,000 during their three co-op rotations. Previous engineering related work experience can be considered for transfer credits.

Dual Enrollment – To ease the transition between Madonna and UDM, it may be recommended to take one or more courses at UDM while completing courses at Madonna. Contact a department advisor for specific courses.

<u>**Teaching Scholars**</u> – The College of Engineering and Science faculty has become a community of *teaching scholars*, leading the nation in attracting National Science Foundation grants (over 30 in recent years) for laboratory instrumentation and curriculum development. All equipment is used in undergraduate instructional labs. Faculty members, not teaching assistants, teach all major courses.

<u>Student Leadership</u> – To gain professional, technical and social connections, we highly encourage participation in at least one of the 25 College organizations or numerous University clubs.
