The purpose of this agreement is to outline the provisions governing the articulation of the Associate Degree in Public Service with a major in Early Care and Education (hereinafter referred to as "Early Care and Education Program") at Central Carolina Technical College and the Bachelor of Science in Education Degree with a major in Early Childhood Education (hereinafter referred to as "Early Childhood Education Program") at Morris College.

Graduates of the Early Care and Education Program at Central Carolina Technical College who complete all courses with a grade of "C" or higher on each course will receive credit toward the Bachelor of Science in Education degree in the Early Childhood Education Program at Morris College as outlined in Attachment 1. (Course articulation is aligned with the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education Statewide Articulation Agreement between Technical College Courses and Public Senior Institutions, Morris College *Transfer Guidelines*, and in-depth review of course syllabi by representatives of both institutions.) Courses not addressed in Attachment 1 will be reviewed on an individual basis, with Morris College being the final authority as to transferability.

This agreement becomes effective with the beginning of the major academic term immediately following the date of final signature and will be reviewed every two years or whenever either institution makes a change in either of the articulated programs.
