

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE
AND
GANNON UNIVERSITY**

PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

This document establishes a transfer articulation agreement between Jamestown Community College and Gannon University. Its purpose is to afford students the opportunity to pre-plan their college careers, and to facilitate the transfer process from the Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) Occupational Therapy Assistant degree program at Jamestown Community College to the Master of Science (M.S.) Occupational Therapy degree program at Gannon University.

GENERAL GUARANTEE OF ADMISSION

Students who graduate from Jamestown Community College with an A.A.S. Occupational Therapy Assistant are guaranteed (1) admission to the M.S. Occupational Therapy program at Gannon University, (2) full junior status, and (3) the opportunity to complete the M.S. degree in Occupational Therapy in one or two summers plus six semesters of normal coursework at Gannon University provided that those Jamestown Community College graduates have met both requirements below.

- A. Achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 at Jamestown Community College, with a grade of "C" or better in all OTA courses.
- B. Taken the following courses at Jamestown Community College and received a grade of "C" or better:
 - (1) CHE 150, Introduction to Chemistry
-or-
CHE 153, Allied Health Chemistry;
 - (2) MAT 154, Elementary Statistics; and
 - (3) PHY 199 (PHY 160), Applied General Physics
-or-
PHY 161, General Physics I and PHY 162, General Physics II.
 - (4) INT 152, Student Success Seminar

This guarantee of admission is for a minimum of five qualified Jamestown Community College graduates per year, with a maximum number to be determined by Gannon University each year based on the number of openings available for juniors.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVISION FOR REVIEW OF AGREEMENT

This agreement will become effective on July 15, 2001. Either institution may terminate this agreement upon six months written notification to the other institution. Review of this agreement will be made every three years, but failure to conduct such a review shall in no way impair any obligation of this agreement.
