



TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDE: ELECTRONIC JOURNALISM

If you are a South Carolina technical college student who plans to transfer to the University's and *pursue the electronic journalism major in the School of Journalism and Mass Communications*, you should consider the following courses as you schedule your technical college classes. The courses listed below will transfer to degree programs within the School of Journalism and Mass Communications. This list does not include every technical college course available for transfer to USC. You are not required to take all courses listed prior to transferring. Rather, it is a guide for you and your advisors.* You should be aware that courses must be passed with a **grade of C or higher** in order to be considered for transfer credit. **You must have a GPA of 2.5 to be considered for admission.** Please review admissions requirements at www.sc.edu/admissions.

School of Journalism and Mass Communications Course Requirements

Technical College Courses

English:

 - c. CHM 101, 105, 106, 107, 110, 111, 112, 211, 212
 - d. PHS 101, 102, 115

English (12 hours):

- 1) ENGL 101 and 102 (6 hours)
- 2) ENGL 287 (3 hours)
- 3) ENGL 288 or 289 (3 hours)

Humanities (9 hours):

- Three courses selected from the following areas:
- a. Art, Music, Film
 - b. Theatre
 - c. Philosophy
 - d. Religion

Social Sciences (12 hours):

- 1) One non-US history (3 hours)
- 2) HIST 111 and 112 (6 hours)
- 3) ECON 224 (3 hours)

Behavioral Sciences (6 hours):

- Two courses selected from the following areas:
- a. Anthropology
 - b. Psychology
 - c. Sociology

Natural Sciences (7-8 hours):

- Two courses selected from the following areas (at least one must include a lab):
- a. Astronomy
 - b. Biology
 - c. Chemistry
 - d. Physics

Required: MAT 120

- c. CPT 101 **and** CPT 111 **or** 112 or 114 or 211

School of Journalism and Mass Communications Course Requirements

Mathematics and Reasoning (6-9 hours):

Required: STAT 201

Choose one of the following options:

- a. MATH 122 or higher level calculus
- b. PHIL 110 and 111
- c. CSCE 101 and 102
- d. An additional STAT course

Foreign Languages (6 hours):

All students must demonstrate proficiency in one foreign language equivalent to the minimal passing grade on the exit examination in the USC 122 course. Students transferring credit equivalent to USC 109 and 110 may enroll in USC 122 to complete the required sequence.
