Articulation Agreement between

JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE and SUNY COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY AT ALFRED

Biological Science

Based on our mutual concern for providing students with the opportunity to receive a quality education in their chosen field that might otherwise be unavailable to them, Jamestown Community College and SUNY College of Technology at Alfred subscribe to the following memorandum of understanding.

Following detailed discussion and exchange of information between personnel representing each institution, it was concluded that there is sufficient similarity between courses required in the *Biological Science* curriculum at the College of Technology at Alfred and the courses offered at Jamestown Community College that a one-plus-one agreement can be established. Students may complete one year of study at Jamestown Community College and subsequently transfer full credit to SUNY College of Technology at Alfred, said credit being fully applicable to the *Biological Science* program subject to the guidelines listed below.

• <u>Time to Complete Degree</u>:

Acceptance of the 34 credits listed above leaves the student with 34 credits to be completed at SUNY/Alfred. These remaining credits and the course offerings at Alfred permit a transferring student to fulfill the curriculum requirements with two additional semesters at SUNY/Alfred if courses are completed satisfactorily.

• Quality Point Index:

With a Quality Point Index (Cumulative Index) of at least 2.0 and passing grades in all transferable courses at Jamestown Community College, the student is guaranteed acceptance into the *Biological Science* program at the SUNY College of Technology at Alfred.
