1. Completion of the AAS degree in Nursing and RN licensure is required before admission to the UB RN/BS Nursing program. No exceptions.
2. **Students are only admitted for Fall semester matriculation and are expected to attend part time at UB while they work as RN’s.**
3. Completion of the SUNYGE Foreign Language requirement is waived for students in Nursing programs at UB.
4. Students can complete this bachelor’s degree in four additional semesters of coursework.
