

SUNY Fredonia-Jamestown Community College Articulation Agreement in Business Administration and Accounting

By this agreement, students who complete the Associate in Science in Business – Business Administration degree at Jamestown Community College are guaranteed admission with full junior standing to their choice of the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration or the Bachelor of Science in Accounting degree programs at SUNY Fredonia. By completing the AS degree and 10/10 SUNY General Education requirements at JCC, such students will be able to complete their BS degree at SUNY Fredonia within 4 additional full-time semesters, taking 15-18 credits per semester.

Business Administration Major Options (Students Choose One):

Finance

Management

Marketing

GPA Criterion: To be guaranteed admission, students must have a cumulative GPA, from all colleges attended of 2.5 or higher.

College Core Curriculum: To graduate with a baccalaureate degree from SUNY Fredonia, students must meet the requirements of SUNY Fredonia's College Core Curriculum (CCC). The CCC includes the SUNY General Education Requirements plus additional coursework stipulated in the Fredonia catalog. To assist JCC students in preparing for their baccalaureate degree at SUNY Fredonia, the additional CCC requirements are summarized below:

- 1) Students are required to complete 2 courses, with 2 different prefixes, in the social sciences. Only one course may be from business administration, education, history, communication or speech.
- 2) Students are required to complete 2 courses, with two different prefixes, in the natural sciences.
- 3) The CCC includes a speaking intensive requirement. This will be fulfilled if students complete the SUNY General Education basic communication requirement at JCC.
- 4) The CCC includes a 6 credit upper-level requirement, which must be completed at Fredonia.

Suggested Coursework at JCC: Appendix A lists requirements for the AS Business-Business Administration degree at JCC, suggests elective courses that fulfill JCC requirements and also transfer well into the BS Business Administration and BS Accounting degree programs at SUNY Fredonia, and lists SUNY Fredonia equivalents for JCC courses.

*Students must complete MATH 120 or the equivalent (MAT 1630) for their Bachelor's Degree. If needed, students may transfer the appropriate non-remedial math course (s) in preparation for MATH 120.

**Students who complete BUS 2530 OR BUS 2540 will satisfy the BUAD 310 requirement for Business Administration majors. Accounting majors will need BUS 2530 AND 2540 or complete the equivalent at SUNY Fredonia.
