

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**  
**SAINT LEO UNIVERSITY**  
**AND**  
**CENTRAL CAROLINA TECHNICAL COLLEGE**

**I. SCOPE AND PURPOSE**

- A. Articulated Programs: Saint Leo University (SLU) and Central Carolina Technical College (CCTC) hereby enter into the following articulation agreement governing the matriculation of the CCTC Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, and Associate in Applied Science Majors in Management, Computer Technology and Criminal Justice Technology into SLU Baccalaureate of Art and Baccalaureate of Science degree programs
- B. Purpose: It is the intention of this articulation agreement to facilitate a seamless transition from the CCTC Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, and Associate in Applied Science Majors in Management, Computer Technology and Criminal Justice Technology to SLU Baccalaureate programs.
- C. Understanding of the parties:
  - 1. For all CCTC Associate in Arts or Associate in Science graduates admitted to Saint Leo University during the term of this agreement, SLU will:
    - a. Accept the students as having junior standing, with the understanding that students may need to complete certain general education courses and prerequisite courses for the program in which they enroll.
    - b. Accept maximum hours transferred (64 semester hours); minimum hours in major with SLU (15 semester hours); total hours needed to graduate (minimum 120 semester hours).
    - c. Accept student as having fulfilled all SLU general education requirements except for the SLU third tier Religion course. AA and AS coursework also is applied to meet major and elective degree requirements as applicable up to the limit allowed from community colleges per policy as set forth in the current SLU Catalog.
    - d. Accept transfer credit for courses in which a "D" grade was given.

2. For all CCTC Associate in Applied Science Majors in Management, Computer Technology and Criminal Justice Technology graduates admitted to SLU during the term of this agreement, SLU will:
  - a. Accept transfer students as having junior standing, with the understanding that some students may need to complete certain general education and prerequisite courses for the program in which they enroll.
  - b. Accept maximum hours transferred (64 semester hours); minimum hours in major with SLU (15 semester hours); total hours needed to graduate (minimum 120 semester hours).
  - c. Accept coursework as transferable to Saint Leo University on a course by course basis as applied to meet general education, major and electives degree requirements as applicable up to the limit allowed from community colleges per policy as set forth in the current SLU Catalog
  - d. Accept transfer credit for courses in which a "D" grade was given.

## II. ARTICULATED PROGRAMS

**A. Associate of Arts (AA) and Associate of Science (AS) Degrees:** Accept student as having fulfilled all SLU general education requirements except for the SLU third tier Religion course. AA and AS coursework also is applied to meet major and elective degree requirements as applicable up to the limit allowed from community colleges per policy as set forth in the current SLU Catalog.

**B. Associate of Applied Science Major in Management Degree:** CCTC Associate of Applied Science Major in Management coursework is transferable to SLU on a course by course basis and is applied to meet general education, Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration with a Specialization in Management, and elective degree requirements as applicable up to the limit allowed from community colleges per policy as set forth in the current SLU Catalog.

### III. BUSINESS AGREEMENT


#### Article 1 – Termination

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon at least ninety (90) days written notice given by either party.


This agreement shall continue in effect for five (5) years from the date it has been signed by both parties, unless terminated by either party in writing of their desire to have it terminated. The agreement and understanding that termination will not be executed without a negotiated teach-out agreement for students currently enrolled.

#### Article 2 – Acceptance by Parties

The parties are committed to the concept of a long-standing agreement. This agreement will be amended when Articles are added, deleted, or significantly modified. Amendments must be in writing and may take the form of letters signed by the signatories or their designees. The agreement may be reviewed at any time at the request of either party.




