And

LESLEY UNIVERSITY

OBJECTIVES OF THIS AGREEMENT:

1. To attract qualified students to Bristol Community College and Lesley University.
2. To promote and facilitate an efficient transition of transfer students from Bristol Community College into junior status in the Adult Baccalaureate Programs at Lesley University with the opportunity for the students to complete the baccalaureate degree.
3. To provide specific information and guidelines for transfer students.
4. To encourage academic coordination and cooperation, including curricular reviews, on-site visitation and joint academic advising for students attending Bristol Community College.
5. To provide a framework for the exchange of information to monitor the success of this agreement.

STIPULATIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT:

1. This agreement will apply to Bristol Community College transfer students who have completed a minimum of sixty semester hours in the A.A. in while following the attached prescribed outline of courses for transfer credit.
2. Transfer students designated above will be accepted into junior status at Lesley University.
3. It is understood that, as a general rule, students transferring from two-year colleges must complete a minimum of 60 credits for the baccalaureate degree and receive a grade c or better for transfer of credit.

MUTUAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Both institutions agree to maintain current listings of the course equivalencies. This will be the responsibility of the two designated representatives.
2. The Bristol Community College Director of Transfer Affairs will be responsible for assisting the transfer applicant in compiling the required credentials for application which shall include an application form, required fee, written personal statement, 2 letters of recommendation and official college transcript.
3. Lesley's Dean of Enrollment Planning will forward a letter of acceptance when application is completed.
4. Transfer applicants applying under this program shall be eligible for the same financial aid as other entering students.

ASSISTANCE PROVISIONS

1. Bristol Community College will incorporate a summary of this agreement into official publications.
2. Bristol Community College and Lesley University both agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this program by providing advising, information, and such other assistance required to assure that an easy transition from the two-year institution to the four-year institution will occur.

REVIEW/REVISION PROVISIONS:

1. Review of the contents or implementations of this agreement will occur whenever requested by either party through the designated representatives. Substantive changes in the courses or program of either institution will evoke review processes. Revisions must be mutually agreed upon, with one-year notice prior to termination of the agreement.

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS
Between
BRISTOL COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND LESLEY UNIVERSITY

The above institutions hereby enter into an agreement to facilitate the transfer of students enrolled in three Associates degree programs at Bristol Community College into Lesley University's Adult Baccalaureate Programs:

- A.S. in Human Services—to the B.S. degree program Human Services with a specialization in Counseling, or Human Services with a specialization in Management
- A.A. in Elementary Education --to the B.A. degree program Leading to initial licensure in American Studies /Elementary Education (Grades 1-6)
- A.S in Early Childhood Education – to the B.A. degree Leading to initial licensure in Human Development / Early childhood Education (pre K-2)

Lesley's designated representative will be the Assistant Director of Admissions and Bristol Community College representative will be the Director of Transfer Affairs.
