WARNER PACIFIC COLLEGE BASIC COURSES REQUIRED OF ALL DEGREES

(For students transferring to Warner Pacific without an Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree)

Warner Pacific Requirements--a minimum of 42 semester hours from the following categories: **MHCC Equivalent** **Qtr Credits**

COMMUNICATIONS:

Three courses, including one full year of college composition. WR 121 and 122 and 123 9

HUMANITIES:

Five courses. Freshman and sophomore transfers (less than 90 qtr. hours) complete 2 courses in 2 areas of History, Literature and/or Philosophy, plus 3 Humanities courses at WPC. Any HST, PHL, or Literature (ENG prefix) course (2-3 courses in two areas) Min 3 credits each

Junior transfers (90 qtr hours or more) complete 3 courses in 2 areas of History, Literature, and/or Philosophy, plus 2 Humanities courses at WPC.

RELIGION:

Freshman and Sophomore transfers complete 3 identified courses. Junior transfers complete 2 courses. At least one additional religion course will be taken while attending Warner Pacific. Choose from: ENG 275, R210 Min 3 credits each

MATHEMATICS:

One course: MTH 100 or higher. Choose one course from MTH 100 or higher. 4-5

SCIENCE:

One course, with regular lab experience. Any Science course with accompanying lab. 4-5

FINE ARTS :

Choose 6 quarter credits, at least one from:

Four semester credits from Art, Drama, Fine Arts or Music. One course chosen must emphasize the cultural/historical aspects of the art form. Additional course(s) must be participatory or performance oriented.

ART 167, 201, 202, 203, 211, 212, 213. MUS 101, 105, 205, 208, 261, 262, 263. TA 101, 102, 103. Other coursework from ART, MUP, MUS, or TA. 6

NOTES:

1. Warner Pacific College accepts the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree as meeting all lower division general education requirements EXCEPT FOR the Religion requirement and **HUM** 310 and 410 to be taken at Warner Pacific.
2. If planning to enroll fall semester, apply early in the academic year. For spring semester enrollment, send application at least 2 months prior to the start of term.
3. Only courses numbered 100 or higher are accepted, except as noted.
4. A maximum 108 quarter credits may be transferred.
5. Warner Pacific College requires a minimum 2.0 transfer GPA. Transfer students enrolling with fewer than 20 semester credits (30 quarter credits) must also provide high school transcripts and SAT scores.
6. In conversion from quarter to semester credits, the number of quarter credits earned is multiplied by .67 (EXAMPLE: 30 qtr cr multiply .67 = 20.1 semester cr.).
7. No professional/technical "applied science" courses, "special project" courses, or "cooperative work experience" courses will be accepted for core requirements.
8. Unofficial transcript evaluations are available anytime. Call 503-517-1020.
9. To enter with sophomore standing, a minimum of 30 semester (45 quarter) credits must be transferable; to enter with junior standing, a minimum of 60 semester (90 quarter) credits must be transferable.
10. Courses in the major may duplicate courses in the core curriculum.
