For general education elective options at Bucks CC, Drexel recommends equivalent courses in communications, english, music, sociology, psychology, fine arts, foreign languages, philosophy, history, political science, and anthropology. For math courses at Bucks CC, Drexel recommends MATH 117, MATH 118, and MATH 115 or 215. Please refer to CollegeTransfer.net for course equivalents.

For students enrolling in the business program at Drexel, a maximum of 90 quarter credits will transfer and out of the 90 quarter credits only 28 quarter credits in business (or 7 required business courses) will transfer. Those courses include Intro to Business, Financial and Managerial Accounting, Business Law, Statistics, and Macro/Micro Economics.

To receive transfer credit, the courses must be substantially equivalent to courses offered in the desired curriculum at Drexel and you must have completed the courses with a grade of C (C=2.0) or better. The transfer courses listed should be used as a general guide and might not be acceptable for every major at the University. We make every effort to keep this guide current but cannot guarantee that every course will be acceptable for transfer. The number of credits you can transfer will be determined by the academic department once you've been accepted.
