2+2 Agreement

This document is an amendment to the original articulation agreement of September 9, 1994. This agreement supersedes any previous agreements.

School of Continuing Studies, Tulane University

and

Delgado Community College

Tulane University School of Continuing Studies and Delgado Community College enter into this agreement with the goal of facilitating the transition of students from selected Delgado Community College academic programs to four-year academic programs offered through and by the School of Continuing Studies. This agreement pertains only to students who have successfully completed the Delgado Community College degree program specified in this document. Students transferring from the specified Delgado Community College programs to the School of Continuing Studies will have credits applied according to the following guidelines:

- 1. Students at Delgado Community College who successfully complete the associate degree programs specified in this agreement will receive 60 credits toward a bachelor's degree program offered through and by the School of Continuing Studies. These students must then successfully complete an additional 60 credits at the School of Continuing Studies to earn a degree in one of the programs offered by the School of Continuing Studies. A minor is not required for these students.
- 2. The School of Continuing Studies will apply no more than one-half of the total number of credits to any particular major available through the School of Continuing Studies.

Tulane University School of Continuing Studies will accept all degree credits (up to 60 credits) from Delgado Community College according to the following guidelines:

I. From the associate degree programs in Computer Information Technology, Criminal Justice, Fine Arts, General Science, and Performance and Media Arts:

Students who successfully complete any one of these academic programs from Delgado Community College will receive 60 credits toward a bachelor's degree offered through and by the School of Continuing Studies.

II. From Delgado Community College degree programs not named in this document:

Students who do not complete a Delgado Community College degree specified in this document or who choose to transfer into one of Tulane University's full-time divisions will have their courses individually evaluated. Only students completing one of the aforementioned degree programs at Delgado Community College are assured of transferring their credits in toto, and the transfer applies only to degrees offered through and by the School of Continuing Studies. Students majoring in General Studies at Delgado Community College should meet with an advisor at Tulane University School of Continuing Studies to determine applicability of course work for transfer into the School of Continuing Studies.
