Program for MACC and MU*

This agreement provides students who have earned an **Associate of Arts with an emphasis in Business** the opportunity to complete a **Bachelor of Science in Business Administration** at MU. Pending admission to the MU College of Business any MACC student who has earned an Associate of Arts with an emphasis in Business is guaranteed that MU will accept designated freshman and sophomore business credits and all general education credits and will apply such to the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree in a manner consistent with the treatment of native students.

**Conditions for Admission**

A maximum of 64 credit hours will be accepted by MU from MACC to be applied to the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. Students must complete 30 of the last 36 hours in residence at MU, enrolled in MU College of Business courses.

Admission into the upper level emphasis area is competitive; students must have a 2.6 UM cumulative GPA to apply, but that does not guarantee admission. Capacity is determined by each of the individual departments. Alternate business related majors are available to students who do not gain admission to College of Business Programs which would build on the same course work specified by this agreement.
