## Business Administration Associate of Science Degree

### Articulation Agreement with Eastern Oregon University's Business Economics Major

A total of 97 credits comprised of: business core requirements, general education skill courses, and general education core classes, must be completed to earn UCC's Associate of Science degree that will allow students to transfer easily into Eastern Oregon University's Business Economics degree. A grade of C- or better must be achieved on all courses used to fulfill degree requirements.

Eastern Oregon University's Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts in Business Economics is a liberal arts program designed to give students a strong theoretical background in business and economics. Graduates in this degree will be prepared for graduate programs in the areas of management, accounting, finance, and economics. This degree program is offered on the Eastern Campus, and Online.

### General University Graduation Requirements

- 180 -- minimum credits required to graduate from EOU
- 60 -- minimum credits of upper division (300 & 400 level) credits required to graduate from EOU
- 60 -- General Education Core credits required to graduate from EOU
- 45 -- minimum credits must be earned from EOU
- 120 - maximum credits that can be transferred to EOU from accredited institutions
- 12 -- maximum vocational/technical elective credits can be transferred
- "C"-- the minimum grade required in courses used to satisfy both Program and General Education requirements
- Math - Students must complete a college level math course. (See EOU catalog for details.)
- Writing -- Students must complete the University Writing Requirements. (See EOU catalog)
- Language - two years of college level foreign language or its equivalent required for a BA degree
