All lower division Baccalaureate Core, and lower division Tourism and Outdoor Leadership major and option course requirements will be considered as having been fulfilled. This agreement is based on the evaluation of the rigor and content of COCC's coursework, OSU's Baccalaureate Core, and the Tourism and Outdoor Leadership degree requirements.

Note: Students may only transfer 124 lower-division credits towards an Oregon State University Baccalaureate degree. This agreement is subject to yearly re-evaluation by both schools for continuance. Changes to degree requirements or courses at either institution will necessitate an addendum that will be attached to this articulation agreement.

#### Additional Comments:

- This agreement specifies 93 credit hours (not including option courses) and upon completion students will be awarded the Associate of Science degree. Students who are accepted into OSU will have met all of the lower division Baccalaureate Core requirements.
- This agreement affects students beginning fall 2010. Prior to fall 2010 students will follow that agreement in effect upon their entry into the program.
- This agreement does not include a list of upper division courses required for the Baccalaureate Core; i.e., Synthesis courses and WIC, or for the major.
- Note: No more than 12 professional/technical credit hours may be used.
- Students must choose one of the following three options for the B.S. Tourism and Outdoor Leadership:
  - > Adventure Leadership and Education Option
  - > Eco and Adventure Tourism Option
  - > International Ecotourism Option
- Each of the options have lower division requirements.
