For

**TRANSFER of COURSES BETWEEN CHEMEKETA COMMUNITY COLLEGE
and OREGON STATE UNIVERSITY – CASCADES CAMPUS**

2003-2004 Catalog

It is agreed that students transferring from Chemeketa Community College having completed their Dietetics Transfer Option Undergraduate degree with the courses listed in this agreement will be granted the following course equivalencies in the Bachelor of Science degree in Nutrition and Food Management with an Option in Dietetics program at Oregon State University. This agreement is based on the evaluation of the rigor and content of the Dietetics Transfer Option degree requirements at Chemeketa Community College and the BACC Core requirements at OSU along with and the Bachelor of Science degree in Nutrition and Food Management with the Option in Dietetics requirements. This agreement is subject to yearly re-evaluation by both schools for continuance.

Students may transfer a maximum of 124 credits towards a Baccalaureate degree at OSU.



Chemeketa Community College Dietetics Transfer Program Agreement with Oregon State University

The following understandings apply to Chemeketa Community College Dietetics Transfer Program students who intend to transfer to Oregon State University (OSU) to enter the Bachelor of Science Degree Program in Dietetics:

Oregon State University (OSU) agrees to accept in transfer from Chemeketa Community College a minimum of 91 and a maximum of 108 quarter credits from students who have completed the Dietetics Transfer courses as outlined in Appendix A.


Provided that there are at least 90 hours in transferable credits, students will be admitted with junior level status into Oregon State University. If students complete all courses listed in Appendix A, they will be accepted into the Bachelor of Science in Dietetics at OSU.

Courses taken from Appendix A (MTH111 and WR122 must be graded at "C" level or above to be accepted) will be applied to the Dietetics Option degree in the following manner:

- (a) 10 credits towards the Dietetics Option Major
- (b) 81 credits of lower division general education, which apply toward the OSU baccalaureate core.

For advice about undergraduate course requirements, students can contact the College of Health and Human Sciences Student Support and Advising Office at 541-737-8900.

OSU and CCC agree to communicate all changes in their Dietetics degree programs annually by no later than June 30th, and if necessary to modify this agreement accordingly. Program directors will be in frequent contact to maintain a close relationship between the two programs.
