Each course offered at the Community College of Beaver County has been evaluated, and transferability of each course has been determined.

The University of Pittsburgh will accept a maximum of 60 credits from a community college. All courses transfer as lower level, freshman and sophomore level courses. A grade earned in a class taken at the Community College of Beaver County will not replace the grade from an equivalent class taken at the University of Pittsburgh.

Students planning to pursue a major offered through any other school at the University of Pittsburgh should consult the "Pitt Connection" for that school's transfer policies.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Note: A grade of C or better is required for transfer.
