General Studies Transfer Equivalents

To transfer to the Graziadio School of Business and Management's Bachelor of Science in Management program, a student must have earned an acceptable grade point average on 68 or more transferable semester units from a regionally accredited college or university. Students should be employed on a full-time basis or have significant prior work experience in order to relate to the other students and the material covered in the course. Final decision of transferable courses will be made by admission representatives at the Graziadio School of Business and Management, Pepperdine University.

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to application for admission to the BSM Program)

AREA 2: MATHEMATICS

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to application for admission to the BSM Program)

MATHEMATICS 102, 103, 104, 111, 140, 211, 240

AREA 3: ARTS AND HUMANITIES

(At least 3 courses = 9 semester units from Area 3)

All courses listed in the Associate Degree General Education requirements under Area C: Humanities for the AA degree **OR** Area C: Art, Literature, Philosophy and Foreign Language for CSU Breadth **OR** Area 3: Arts and Humanities for IGETC **PLUS** the additional courses identified below:

AREA 4: SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE

(At least 4 courses = 12 semester units;

one course for 3 semester units **must** be in US History or American Government)

All courses listed in the Associate Degree General Education requirements under Area A: Natural Sciences for the AA degree **OR** Area B1: Physical Science or B2: Life Science for CSU Breadth **OR** Area 5: Physical and Biological Sciences for IGETC.

AREA 6: LIFELONG LEARNING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Additional 15 GE units to satisfy the minimum 45 units GE requirement may be drawn from any of the above subject areas <u>PLUS</u> those courses listed under:

Area F: Health Education and Area G: Physical Education (4 units maximum) for the AA degree **OR** Area B4: Mathematics / Quantitative Reasoning **and** Area E: Life-Long Understanding and Self-Development (four-unit limit on activity courses) for CSU Breadth **OR**

Area 2: Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning for IGETC

<u>PLUS</u> courses from <u>COMPUTER INFORMATION SYSTEMS.</u>

AREA 7: ELECTIVES

An additional 23-35 semester units of course work from Areas 1 to 6 above <u>PLUS</u> AA/AS major preparation courses. Other courses not listed above that are applicable to the AA degree may be reviewed for applicability as electives. Students are encouraged to take courses from the following areas to enhance their preparation for the Graziadio School's BSM program: ACCOUNTING; BANKING AND FINANCE; BUSINESS; BUSINESS INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY; HOSPITALITY; MARKETING.

In addition, the following courses have been articulated so as to provide an option for students to WAIVE UP TO 12 UNITS OF BSM COURSE WORK, thus reducing the residential units to be taken at Pepperdine to 48 units. A minimum of four additional elective units are required for each four-unit course waived.

Grade B or better in ACCTG 1A (4) and ACCTG 1B (4) OR ACCTG 106 to waive BSM 472 Accounting (4)
Grade B or better in ECON 1A (3) <u>and</u> ECON 1B (3) to waive BSM 469 Managerial Economics (4)
