## **General Studies Course Transfer Agreement**

To transfer to the Graziadio School of Business and Management's Bachelor of Science in Management program, a student must have earned an acceptable grade point average on 68 or more transferable semester units from a regionally accredited college or university. Students should be employed on a full-time basis or have significant prior work experience in order to relate to the other students and the material covered in the courses. Final decision of transferable courses will be made by admission representatives at the Graziadio School of Business and Management, Pepperdine University. Eligibility of transfer for General Education courses from Golden West College are based on the degree requirements for the *Associate Degree in Arts*.

#### AREA 1: ENGLISH COMPOSITION

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to application for admission to the BSM Program)

#### **AREA 2: MATHEMATICS**

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to application for admission to the BSM Program)

#### **AREA 3: ARTS AND HUMANITIES**

(At least 3 courses = 9 semester units from Area 3)

All courses (except Art, Music, Dance and Theater Arts activities courses – see Area 6) listed in the General Education requirements for the AA degree under Groups 1 and 3 in Area A: Communication in the English Language and Critical Thinking, Area; **OR** Area A1 and A3: English Language Communication and Critical Thinking and Area C: Arts and Humanities for CSU GE-Breadth; **OR** Area 1 English Communications and Area 3: Arts and Humanities for IGETC. Credit limitations apply in Art, Dance, and Music.

#### AREA 4: SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE

(At least 4 courses = 12 semester units; **one** course for 3 semester units **must** be in US History or American Government)

The following courses meet the U.S. History or American Government requirement:

**HISTORY** G170, G175 **POLITICAL SCIENCE** G180, G180H

The remaining nine units (3 courses) can be taken from courses listed above or all courses listed in the General Education requirements for the AA degree under Area D: Social, Political, and Economic Institutions; **OR** Area D: Social Sciences for CSU GE-Breadth; **OR** Area 4: Social and Behavioral Sciences for IGETC.

## AREA 5: PHYSICAL AND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units)

All courses listed in the General Education requirements for the AA degree under Group 1 of Area B: Physical Universe and Its Life Forms; **OR** Area B1: Physical Science and B2: Life Science for CSU GE-Breadth; **OR** Area 5: Physical and Biological Sciences for IGETC.

#### AREA 6: LIFELONG LEARNING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Additional 15 GE units to satisfy the minimum 45 units GE requirement may be drawn from any of the above subject areas <u>PLUS</u> (unit limits apply to some categories):

## **AREA 7: ELECTIVES**

An additional 23-35 semester units of course work from Areas 1 to 6 above <u>PLUS</u> AA/AS major preparation courses. Other courses not listed above that are applicable to the AA and AS degrees may be reviewed for applicability as electives. Students are encouraged to take courses from any business-related area to enhance their preparation for the Graziadio School's BSM program.

In addition, the following courses have been articulated so as to provide an option for students to WAIVE UP TO 12 UNITS OF BSM COURSE WORK, thus reducing the residential units to be taken at Pepperdine to 48 units. A minimum of four additional elective units are required for each four-unit courses waived.

- Grade B or better in ACCTG G101 (4) and ACCTG G102(4) to waive ACCT 472Accounting (4)
- Grade B or better in ECON G180 (3) and ECON G285 (3) to waive ECNM 469 Managerial Economics (4)
- Grade B or better in COMP SCI G130 (4) and COMP SCI G170 (3) to waive ISTM 476 Information Systems for Business and Management (4)

Note that students who waive any of the above courses in the BSM program and who subsequently enroll in the MBAJ program will be required to complete the equivalent MBA core course.
