AREA 7: ELECTIVES

An additional 23-35 semester units of course work from Areas 1 to 6 above <u>PLUS</u> AA major preparation courses. Other courses not listed above that are applicable to the AA degree may be reviewed for applicability as electives. Students are encouraged to take courses from any business-related area to enhance their preparation for the Graziadio School's BSM program.

In addition, the following courses have been articulated so as to provide an option for students to WAIVE UP TO 12 UNITS OF BSM COURSE WORK, thus reducing the residential units to be taken at Pepperdine to 48 units. A minimum of four additional elective units are required for each four-unit courses waived.

- Grade B or better in ACCTG 1A (4) and ACCTG 1B(4) to waive ACCT 472 Accounting (4)
- Grade B or better in ECON 1 (3) and ECON 2 (3) to waive ECNM 469 Managerial Economics (4)

Note that students who waive any of the above courses in the BSM program and who subsequently enroll in the MBAJ program will be required to complete the equivalent MBA core course.
