To fulfill the Health Services Administration Program's Math Requirement a student must complete two college-level Math courses.

To fulfill the Health Services Administration Program's Natural Life Science Requirement, a student must complete any combination of two courses from the following: biology, chemistry or anatomy and physiology.

American Government and Introduction to Sociology are required courses for the Health Services Administration major. While both courses are offered at Drexel, it is recommended that a student complete these courses prior to transferring to Drexel.

To receive transfer credit, the courses must be substantially equivalent to courses offered in the desired curriculum at Drexel and you must have completed the courses with a grade of C (C=2.0) or better. The transfer courses listed should be used as a general guide and might not be acceptable for every major at the University. We make every effort to keep this guide current but cannot guarantee that every course will be acceptable for transfer. The number of credits you can transfer will be determined by the academic department once you've been accepted.
