ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between

Moore College of Art & Design

Bachelor of Fine Arts in Fine Arts: 3D Emphasis

AND

Montgomery County Community College Associate of Fine Arts in Fine Art

Moore College of Art & Design (Moore) and Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) are entering into this agreement in order to facilitate the transfer of students who have earned the "Associate of Fine Arts" degree in Fine Art, from MCCC. The articulation provides for entry into Moore's Fine Arts Department with junior level standing and transfer of credit under the guidelines below:

- 1. MCCC students successfully complete the courses as described in the attached document and attain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
- 2. MCCC student's application for admission and consideration for advanced standing in Moore's program covered under this agreement must be supported by a letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the Fine Art Department at MCCC.
- 3. The application fee for admission will be waived for MCCC students applying to Moore.
- 4. Students must follow and complete the application procedures as outlined in the Moore College of Art & Design catalog.
- 5. In accordance with Moore College of Art & Design Admissions requirements, a portfolio of artwork must be submitted for review by the Admissions Office. The admissions portfolio must contain between 12 and 20 pieces of artwork as required of all BFA applicants.
- Students must also present the work from their major-related courses at MCCC for review by the department chairperson of Fine Arts, on which the assignment of transfer credits is based.
- 7. A grade of "C" or better is required for transfer of credit in all courses. In order to transfer with advanced standing, students must complete the recommended course work at MCCC which parallels Moore programs as outlined.
- 8. Maximum allowable number of transfer credits applied from MCCC toward the BFA degree at Moore is 76.0 credits.
- 9. This contract will be mutually renegotiated on a year-to-year basis to determine if adjustments should be made. Amendments to this agreement may be made when necessary for the improvement of transfer procedures. The council on Academic Standards (or the equivalent of that council) at each institution should be notified in writing of any changes to courses or programs that might affect this agreement.
- 10. Moore will annually provide Montgomery County Community College with aggregate statistical information regarding the number of applicants, applicant credentials, and admissions decisions, in addition to aggregated academic progress data of Montgomery
