
**DUAL ADMISSION AGREEMENT
CORE-TO-CORE TRANSFER AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
MONTGOMERY COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE
AND
GWYNEDD-MERCY COLLEGE**

Preface

1. Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) and Gwynedd-Mercy College enter into this Dual Admission and Core-to-Core Agreement to facilitate the transfer of MCCC students to Gwynedd-Mercy College.
2. Under the Dual Admissions Agreement, MCCC students will be guaranteed admissions into a parallel Bachelor's Degree program with third year (junior) status at Gwynedd-Mercy College on the condition that they do the following:
 - graduate from MCCC with an Associate in Arts (A.A.), an Associate of Science (A.S.), or an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) [specific A.A.S. programs included in this agreement are Early Childhood Education, Nursing, Medical Laboratory Technician, Criminal Justice, or Human Services] with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

To assure transfer to Gwynedd-Mercy College with third year (junior) status, students enrolled in the Early Childhood Education (A.A.S.) program at MCCC must complete an additional three credit MCCC course that will satisfy one of the requirements for the B.S. in Elementary Education at Gwynedd-Mercy College. In addition, students enrolled in the Early Childhood Education program at MCCC will need to complete HIS 203 (History of the U.S. to 1877) or HIS 205 (History of the U.S. from 1877) at MCCC in place of HIS 103, 105 or 107 (History of Western Civilization). Approval from the MCCC Division Chair of Social Sciences is required to substitute HIS 203 or 205 for HIS 103, 105 or 107.

A full-time student admitted with third year (junior) status to Gwynedd-Mercy College will be able to complete a Bachelor's Degree at Gwynedd-Mercy College within four regular semesters (with the exception of the B.S. in Medical Technology) provided that the student completes the appropriate Associate Degree program requirements at MCCC and completes and appropriately sequences their remaining required course work at Gwynedd-Mercy College.

- enroll at Gwynedd-Mercy College within one year of MCCC graduation;
 - complete a "Dual Admissions Intent" form;
 - and satisfy all other Gwynedd-Mercy College transfer requirements.
3. In addition, Gwynedd-Mercy College agrees to accept the general education embedded in the MCCC A.A., A.S., and selected A.A.S. degrees (as outlined on page 1) as meeting all the requirements of its undergraduate general education degree requirements. Students must complete all core requirements specific to the major, 3 credits of lower-level philosophy, 3 credits of upper-level philosophy, and 6 credits of religious studies. These credits as well as any prerequisites may be satisfied by completing the appropriate courses through an A.A., A.S., or selected A.A.S. degree program (as outlined on page 1) at MCCC or by completion at Gwynedd-Mercy College.

- The following MCCC courses will satisfy the lower-level philosophy requirement of Gwynedd-Mercy College:

PHI 100 – Introduction to Philosophy (3 credits)

PHI 115 – Problems in Philosophy (3 credits)

PHI 221 – Fundamentals of Ethics (3 credits)

- The following MCCC course will satisfy the upper-level philosophy requirement of Gwynedd-Mercy College:

PHI 225 Logic: Classical Logic (3 credits)

- The following MCCC course will satisfy a religious studies requirement of Gwynedd-Mercy College:

PHI 215 Comparative Religions (3 credits)

- Electives completed at MCCC will satisfy general education and/or major course requirements as outlined the *Appendix I – MCCC Course Equivalency Guide*.

4. The residency requirement of Gwynedd-Mercy College refers to the number of credits a matriculated student must complete at Gwynedd-Mercy College to be considered a candidate for a bachelor's degree. The residency requirement is 45 to 50 credits depending on the student's specific program of study. It is expected that once matriculated a student complete all course work at Gwynedd-Mercy College.

The residency requirement for degree programs is as follows:

- B.S. Programs within the School of Allied Health.....45 credits

Bachelor's of Health Science with the following concentrations in Behavioral and Social Gerontology, Cardiovascular Science, Clinical Laboratory Sciences, Communications, Computer & Information Sciences, Education, Gerontology; Health Information Administration, Human Resources; Management; Natural Science; and Radiation Therapy Technology

Bachelor's of Science in Medical Technology

- B.S. Programs within the School of Arts & Science..... 50 credits

Bachelor's of Arts in Behavioral and Social Gerontology, Biology, English, History, Mathematics, Psychology, Psychology/Sociology, and Sociology

Bachelor's of Science in Biology, Mathematics, Psychology, and Sociology

- B.S. Programs within the School of Business & Computer Info Sciences..... 45 credits

Bachelor's of Science in Accounting, Business Administration, Business Education, and Computer & Information Sciences

- Programs within the School of Education.....50 credits

Bachelor's of Science in Elementary Education and Special Education

- Programs within the School of Nursing45 credits

Bachelor's of Science in Nursing

5. This Dual Admissions and Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement becomes effective on February 7, 2000.
6. To facilitate the transfer of MCCC graduates to Gwynedd-Mercy College in accordance with the foregoing guarantee, the parties agree to the following:

Obligations of Gwynedd-Mercy College

1. To send a letter each semester to all A.A., A.S., and A.A.S. MCCC students inviting their interest and attention to transfer to Gwynedd-Mercy College after earning their degree. The letter will include an invitation to a partnership evening program at MCCC to discuss this opportunity and to complete a "Dual Admission Intent" form. Gwynedd-Mercy College will attend regularly scheduled Partner Day and Evening Programs at MCCC. Gwynedd-Mercy College will provide MCCC with "Dual Admission Intent" forms and fact sheets to distribute upon request.
2. To invite MCCC students who have completed a "Dual Admission Intent" form to an informational/advising meeting with Gwynedd-Mercy College faculty and/or staff on a regular basis at both MCCC and Gwynedd-Mercy College, in order to facilitate smooth curricular and co-curricular integration to Gwynedd-Mercy College.
3. To send a Gwynedd-Mercy College letter of admission to all MCCC students who complete a "Dual Admissions Intent" form and meet the conditions set forth in the Preface. Students must confirm their intention to matriculate at Gwynedd-Mercy College by August 1st for the fall semester, and by December 1st for the spring semester, and satisfy all other regular Gwynedd-Mercy College admission requirements. MCCC students who complete a "Dual Admissions Intent" form will be governed by the Gwynedd-Mercy College degree requirements in effect at the time of signing the "Dual Admissions Intent" form.
4. To waive the application fee for students who apply to Gwynedd-Mercy College pursuant to this Agreement.
5. To award academic scholarships to all qualified graduates admitted to Gwynedd-Mercy College pursuant to this Agreement. Full-time Gwynedd-Mercy College students (enrolled in 12 or more credits a semester) with a 3.00 – 3.29 final cumulative MCCC GPA will receive a \$6,000 scholarship; full-time students with a 3.30 – 4.00 final cumulative MCCC GPA will receive a \$7,500 scholarship. Full-time scholarship awards may be renewed for up to two (2) years contingent upon the student maintaining a 3.00 cumulative G.P.A. Part-time students who are enrolled in 6 to 11 credits a semester at Gwynedd-Mercy College with a final MCCC cumulative GPA of 3.00 or above will receive a scholarship equivalent to 25% of the per credit cost. Part-time scholarships may be renewed for up to four (4) years contingent upon maintaining a 3.00 cumulative G.P.A. Students are expected to complete the financial aid process to determine eligibility for need-based financial aid and other types of financial aid.
6. To support a core-to-core articulation agreement that allows the MCCC general education core for the A.A., A.S., or selected A.A.S. degree (as outlined on page 1) to fulfill all Gwynedd-Mercy College core requirements to be taken at Gwynedd-Mercy College (see Preface #3). Eligible MCCC graduates enrolling at Gwynedd-Mercy College will be identified upon admission to Gwynedd-Mercy College, and the fact that they have satisfied core requirements by core-to-core transfer will be noted on pertinent Gwynedd-Mercy College records.
7. To accept core-to-core transfers as satisfying all the requirements of the Gwynedd-Mercy College core curriculum (see Preface #3). Core-to-core transfer does not alter the requirements of the student's major or its admission standard as identified in the Gwynedd-Mercy College catalog. Courses for which a passing grade (A, B, C, D) was received will transfer. However, a grade of D will not transfer into a student's major.
8. MCCC graduates entering Gwynedd-Mercy College under the terms of this agreement go through Gwynedd-Mercy College's transfer process and therefore must meet all applicable Gwynedd-Mercy College requirements and deadlines pertaining to application for admission, orientation, registration, and payment of tuition and fees. They will abide by the policies and procedures, and any revisions thereof, that apply to all Gwynedd-Mercy College students.

9. To continue working with MCCC on program-to-program curriculum articulation agreements that specify for MCCC transfer students the MCCC courses that satisfy major requirements required for degree completion at Gwynedd-Mercy College.
10. To ensure that when MCCC dual admissions students matriculate at Gwynedd-Mercy College they will have all the rights and privileges of other Gwynedd-Mercy College students.
11. Waive placement tests for MCCC graduates.
12. Provide MCCC with copies all promotional literature published about the dual admission agreement.

Obligations of Montgomery County Community College

1. Publicize this Agreement to prospective and current MCCC students in its promotional literature, to make special arrangements for Gwynedd-Mercy College recruiters and advisors to visit MCCC to meet with prospective and current Dual Admissions students.
2. Provide Gwynedd-Mercy College with copies of all promotional literature published about the dual admission agreement.

Joint Obligations

1. Consult with each other through appropriate channels prior to implementing major changes in policy or curricula that directly affect students transferring under the terms of this Agreement, and keep each other informed of any other changes of policy or curricula that affect those students. Both Gwynedd-Mercy College and MCCC will review this Agreement annually and make any changes upon mutual agreement, as needed. Such changes will become effective when both MCCC and Gwynedd-Mercy College sign the revised document.
2. Collaborate in providing students with academic advising and information about this agreement, Gwynedd-Mercy College's academic requirements, and the process of transferring to Gwynedd-Mercy College.
3. MCCC and Gwynedd-Mercy College jointly agree to develop and implement advertising and promotional efforts to communicate the benefits of dual admission and core-to-core transfer.
4. Each institution will designate a representative or representatives who will coordinate the Dual Admission and Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement between the two institutions.
5. Exchange data and documents annually that will contribute to the maintenance and improvement of this core-to-core arrangement. Enhance the transfer process, and promote effective cooperation between institutions. These will consist of data about individual transfer students, including admissions information and grades, retention information, and reports on the results of program reviews, assessments of student learning, and decisions of curricular and other committees. The institutions will exchange data after obtaining appropriate permission from the students as indicated on the Dual Admissions Form.
6. Facilitate and support consultation and collaboration between their faculties related to this agreement, general education, degree requirements, and other academic matters.
7. To provide direct links between Gwynedd-Mercy College and MCCC web sites.

Revisions, Renewal and Termination of this Agreement

Gwynedd-Mercy College and MCCC are responsible for identifying, and communicating to each other, changes in the policies or requirements of their respective institutions that affect this Agreement.

This Agreement will be in effect as of the date of its signing, for students entering Gwynedd-Mercy College on or after January 1, 2000. It will be reviewed annually by the appropriate parties at each institution, and will be renewed automatically until superseded by a new agreement or formally terminated. Either institution may terminate this Agreement at any time by written notice at least one year in advance of the effective date of termination. Should this Agreement be terminated, it is understood that the termination will not apply to students already accepted to Gwynedd-Mercy College under the terms of this Agreement.

The willingness of both institutions to enter this Agreement in order to facilitate the transfer of students from Montgomery County Community College into Gwynedd-Mercy College, and to expand their opportunities for academic success there, is indicated by the following signatures.
