1. Students completing the A.S. in Science in Natural Science - Horticulture and Plant Science Option at Lehigh Carbon Community College will have satisfied their Core-to-Core certification requirements at Temple if they complete a total of 3 courses in the social sciences/humanities plus ENG 106 (College English II) and ENG 111 (Speech). Students will be required to complete the Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement Certification Process in order for their Temple record to reflect the satisfied Core. Students who do not complete the 5 courses in the social sciences/humanities will be required to complete the 45+ Core Curriculum.
2. For this agreement the following areas will satisfy the Social Science/Humanities requirement at **Temple and LCCC**: Arabic (ARB), Art (ART) 101, Chinese (CHN), (ENG) 154 or higher excluding ENG 225, 235, Economics (ECO), French (FRN), German (GRM), Geography (GEO), History (HIS), Interdisciplinary Studies (IDS) 154 , 214, 215, Music (MUS) 101, 105, or 107, Philosophy (PHI), Political Science (PSC), Psychology (PSY), Religion (REL), Sociology (SOC), or Spanish (SPN).
3. Selecting ENG 111 (Speech) to fulfill a Gen Ed elective at LCCC fulfills the Public Speaking (STOC 1111) requirement at Temple and will be used for 1 of the 5 required social science/humanities for the Core-to-Core certification.
4. Students are encouraged to work with their academic advisor/counselor in the selection of appropriate electives.
