2 + 2 AGREEMENT
between
Texas Tech University
and
UT Brownsville and Texas Southmost College**

This agreement summarizes an academic union between Texas Tech University (TTU) and UT Brownsville and Texas Southmost College to jointly support specific programs of study leading to a Bachelor of Science in Architecture. This agreement supplements any existing social contract of understanding between Texas Tech University and UT Brownsville and Texas Southmost College, and is an assertive response to the need for a program in the Southern Texas region which leads to a degree accredited by the National Architectural Accreditation Board (NAAB).


This proposal provides for close peer coordination of curricula content and instruction in the General Architecture and Pre-professional programs at Texas Tech University and the Architecture Program at UT Brownsville and Texas Southmost College and facilitates a seamless transfer for students who are seeking a Bachelor of Science in Architecture at TTU. Students will be able to complete the majority of the first two years of study at UT Brownsville and Texas Southmost College and earn an Associate's Degree in Architecture at UT Brownsville and Texas Southmost College before or after transfer to Texas Tech University. All UT Brownsville and Texas Southmost College courses listed on the most current course transfer agreement form will be accepted toward the Bachelor of Science in Architecture degree at TTU. Admission to the pre-professional program at Texas Tech University will be subject to existing policies and procedures.

The results of this joint enterprise will be monitored by representative of both institutions and will be renewed at least every three years. Termination of this agreement may be initiated whenever either said party believes such action to be in the best interest of those involved.






