An Articulation Agreement Between Lincoln Land Community College and Illinois State University

If a student completes the Agri-Business Management Program and all other appropriate requirements for an Associate in Applied Science Degree at Lincoln Land Community College and is admitted to Illinois State University, that student shall be eligible for this Articulation Agreement.

- 1. This Articulation Agreement is only appropriate for students who transfer from Lincoln Land Community College with an Associate in Applied Science and pursue a Bachelor of Science in Agri-Business from Illinois State University.
- 2. These students must complete the following course requirements at Lincoln Land Community College.
