Maintain a minimum recalculated GPA of 2.00 in all transferable courses.
Students who do not earn a grade of B or better in 2nd semester English Composition must also satisfy a college or department writing requirement.
Complete satisfactorily all Arizona Western College graduation requirements for the Associate of Arts in General Studies degree prior to the date the student intends to transfer to the university; otherwise, transcripts will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
