



**Arizona Transfer Admissions Pathways for  
Bachelor of Arts – Political Science 2011-2012  
College of Social & Behavioral Sciences**

To qualify for the Political Science Pathway, an Arizona Western College student enrolled in the Associate in Arts in Political Science program must:

- Submit an undergraduate application for admission form to University of Arizona during the university's application filing period for acceptance, at least one semester in advance of transfer, and otherwise qualify for admission.
- Maintain a minimum recalculated GPA of 2.0 in all transferable courses.
- Students who do not earn a grade of B or better in 2nd semester English Composition must also satisfy a college or department writing requirement.
- Complete satisfactorily all Arizona Western College graduation requirements for the Associate in Arts in Political Science the requirements listed below prior to the date the student intends to transfer to the university; otherwise, transcripts will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
