To qualify for the Anthropology Pathway, a Central Arizona College student enrolled in the Associate of Arts degree program must:

- Submit an undergraduate application for admission form to University of Arizona during the university's application filing period for acceptance, at least one semester in advance of transfer, and otherwise qualify for admission.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all transferable courses.
- Complete satisfactorily all Central Arizona College graduation requirements for the Associate of Arts degree prior to the date the student intends to transfer to the university; otherwise, transcripts will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
