ELEMENTARY EDUCATION (GRADES K-8)

Table with 4 columns: ALPENA Course, Hrs., Title, CMU Equivalent Course, and Special Notes. Lists English Composition courses (ENG 111, 121, 112, 122) and their equivalents (ENG 101, 201).

Note: Students must complete one ENG 101 and one ENG 201 equivalent course.

Natural Science/Math: Minimum 8 hours from at least two different disciplines

Social Sciences: Minimum 8 hours from at least two different disciplines

Table with 4 columns: ALPENA Course, Hrs., Title, CMU Equivalent Course, and Special Notes. Lists HST 221, PSY 101, PSY 226 and their equivalents (HST 111, PSY 100, PSY 220).

Note: PSY 220 will substitute for HDF 100 at CMU

Humanities: Minimum 8 hours from at least two different disciplines

Select one of the following:

Table with 4 columns: ALPENA Course, Hrs., Title, CMU Equivalent Course, and Special Notes. Lists SPE 121, SPE 123, SPE 126 and their equivalents (COM 101, COM 357, TAI 170).

Select at least 5 additional hours from the following disciplines and or courses: Art, English 125, 126 and all 200 level courses, History 121, 122, Humanities, Music, Performing Arts, Philosophy, Sociology 252

The above distribution of courses fulfills the MACRAO Agreement and will satisfy the University Program portion of your degree at CMU. Please see your Registrar to have your transcript stamped with the MACRAO Agreement Satisfied endorsement. For additional courses that will meet the MACRAO agreement, which are not listed on this guide, please contact the Counseling office at Alpena Community College. Only those courses completed with a grade of "C" or better will transfer to CMU.

If you do not plan to complete the MACRAO agreement, please contact CMU Admissions for direct equivalent ACC general education courses requirements in Social Sciences and Humanities.

CMU and Teacher Education Admissions expect its graduates to demonstrate competency in three areas: English Composition, Math and Speech. A grade of B- or better in ENG 111 or 121 and a grade of “C” or better in the following Alpena courses found on this guide will fulfill these competency requirements: ENG 112 or 122; MTH 113 or higher level math course (except MTH 117, 119); and SPE 121, 123 or 126.

**MAJOR/MINOR COURSES:** These courses should be selected from transferable **Alpena Community College** courses to apply to CMU major/minor options. See Bachelor of Science in Education—Elementary Provisional Certification. Students intending to major or minor in Mathematics should review the CMU Bulletin to identify prerequisite courses that can be completed prior to transfer.

**ADMISSION TO TEACHER EDUCATION at CMU:** Full details of the Teacher Education Program requirements at CMU are available in the current Teacher Education Road Map at [www.ehs.cmich.edu/css](http://www.ehs.cmich.edu/css) .

- Students are required to present evidence of at least 45 clock hours of experience working with children in a classroom setting with a certified teacher prior to their admission to the Teacher Education Program
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.70 (B-) or higher calculated at the time of admission.
- Completion of an equivalent to CMU’s EDU 107 with a minimum grade of B (3.0).
- Completion of an equivalent to either CMU’s ENGLISH 101 or 201 with a minimum grade of B- (2.70).
- Completion of University Competency in both Mathematics and Oral English (Speech) with minimum grades of C (2.0).
- Passing scores on all three sections (Reading; Math; Writing) of the Michigan Basic Skills Test (#96). This is recommended prior to transfer and required by the Michigan Department of Education. Registration is at [www.mttc.nesinc.com](http://www.mttc.nesinc.com) and there is a fee for this commercial test. Request that scores be sent to CMU.
