

# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

## SAINT LEO UNIVERSITY

### AND

## CENTRAL CAROLINA TECHNICAL COLLEGE

### I. SCOPE AND PURPOSE

- A. *Articulated Programs.* Saint Leo University and Central Carolina Technical College hereby enter into the following articulation agreement governing the matriculation of Associate in Applied Science in Human Services, Associate in Applied Science in Criminology, and Associate in Applied Science in Paralegal graduates of Central Carolina Technical College into the Bachelor of Arts in Human Services at Saint Leo University.

This agreement shall become effective on the first day of Central Carolina Technical College's 2019 Spring 1 term. It shall be jointly reviewed and agreed upon every three years by representatives of each institution, prior to the anniversary date of the agreement. In the event of major program changes by either party, this agreement will be revised by the consent of both parties.

- B. *Students.* Saint Leo University will make every effort to ensure that admitted students have received their Associate in Applied Science in Human Services, Associate in Applied Science in Criminology, and Associate in Applied Science in Paralegal degree prior to admission into the Bachelor of Arts in Human Services or the Bachelor of Art in Criminal Justice degree program. Students who are not planning to receive a degree from Central Carolina Technical College, but who need prerequisite courses to enroll at Saint Leo University will be advised by the University's advising staff.
- C. *Purpose.* It is the intention of this articulation agreement to facilitate a seamless transition from the Associate In Applied Science in Human Services, Associate in Applied Science in Criminology, and Associate in Applied Science in Paralegal at Central Carolina Technical College to the Bachelor of Arts in Human Services or the Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice at Saint Leo University.
- D. *Understanding of the parties.* For all Central Carolina Technical College's Associate in Applied Science in Human Services, Associate in Applied Science in Criminology, and Associate in Applied Science in Paralegal admitted to Saint Leo University's Bachelor of Arts in Human Services or Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice degree program during the term of this agreement, Saint Leo University will:
- i. Accept the students as having Junior standing.
  - ii. Accept coursework as transferable to Saint Leo University on a course by course basis as applied to meet general education, prerequisite, major and elective degree requirements.
  - iii. Transfer students who hold an Associate of Applied Science in Human Services degree may be required to complete additional general education courses.
  - iv. Require all students to complete the following courses unless a student has taken equivalent coursework:
    1. ENG 121 and ENG 122
    2. MAT 131
    3. COM 140
    4. Two Religion courses

5. Two Science courses
  6. Two Human Adventure courses
  7. Two Creative Life courses
  8. One Human Mosaic course
  9. One Philosophy course
- v. Accept up to a maximum of 64 semester hours as transfer credits.
- vi. Require a minimum 30 semester hours with SLU including a minimum 15 semester hours in the major, and a minimum 120 semester hours to graduate; a minimum of 39 hours of coursework must be completed at the 300-400 level for the bachelor degrees.
- vii. Accept transfer credit with a grade of "C" or better for the following SLU General Education Foundation courses: ENG 121, MAT 131, and COM 140.
- E. *Severability.* If, for any reason, any provision of this agreement is held invalid, all other provisions of the agreement shall remain in effect. If this agreement in whole is held invalid or cannot be enforced, then to the fullest extent permitted by law any prior agreement between the parties shall be deemed reinstated as if this agreement had not been executed.

Saint Leo University and Central Carolina Technical College agree that this agreement constitutes the sole, full, and complete agreement between these institutions. No amendments, changes, additions, deletions, or modifications to or of this agreement shall be valid unless reduced to writing signed by each institution's representative and attached to this document.
