Adirondack students would receive credit toward the degree program depending on their choices within the elective options:

- <u>Mathematics Elective</u>: UNH requires Intermediate College Algebra or Finite Mathematics; developmental mathematics below this level are not counted toward degree.
- <u>History Elective</u>: UNH requires Western World in Modern Times; U.S. History would not count toward this requirement but would transfer as an elective
- <u>Science Elective</u>: UNH requires a 4-credit science with Laboratory such as Biology, Chemistry, Physics.
- <u>Art/Music/Theatre</u>: Courses which correspond to UNH Core requirements are: Hum 190 Art 101, 111, 112, Mus 101, 124-125 or Thr 101.
- <u>Social Science Electives</u>: UNH requires one from each of two disciplines: Eco 201 & Eco 202, Psc 101, Psc 103, Psc 104, Psy 101 or Soc 101.
