Successful completion of the 2+2 plan requires that a student remain continuously enrolled and graduate with the associate's degree from his or her respective community college. • This is a guide for course work in the major; actual course sequence may vary by student. Please refer to the online student degree evaluation. • Not all courses are offered every semester and some electives may have prerequisites. Students should review the course descriptions in the catalogs of their respective institutions and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly. • Academic plans and course schedules may need to be altered if ACT or Math Placement scores require a student to take precollege courses (e.g., MATH 0900, 0921, or 0925) before taking required math or English courses.

Casper College requirements:

In order to graduate, students must successfully complete a minimum of 60 approved credit hours, with 15 of the last 30 semester hours completed as a degree-seeking student at Casper College, and with a grade point average of 2.0 or higher in those courses counted toward graduation. • Students must earn at least 24 of the semester credits applied toward graduation through the completion of Casper College coursework, including at least six (6) hours with the desired major. • Only courses numbered 1000 or above can be used toward the degree.

University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U.

UW College of Health Sciences Notes:

Performance expectations for majors in the College of Health Sciences exceed institutional requirements. Please discuss with an academic advisor to understand the difference. • Admission to the clinical portions of Health Sciences majors is competitive and is not guaranteed even with minimum qualifications. Be prepared to exceed expectations. • Background checks are required at some point within all Health Sciences majors. Students should undertand the long-term ramifications of all decisions and actions early on so as not to jeopardize future academic and career goals.

UW Program Notes:

• Students must be accepted into the professional degree program as "Admitted to Major" to enroll in the junior and senior level courses listed above.

• Students apply for admission to the professional major in the spring of their sophomore years. Requirements for admission and the application are available on the Division of Social Work website: www.uwyo.edu/socialwork

• Social Work students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 to graduate. Social Work courses must be completed with a C or better. Ten hours of Social Work practicum are required. Students must complete 53 hours in social work to graduate. Core courses are offered once a year in sequence; you must successfully complete the prior semester's courses before enrolling in the next semester courses i.e. you must complete the fall semester courses to be eligible to register for the spring semester courses.
