Laramie County Community College requirements:

In order to graduate, students must successfully complete a minimum of 60 credit hours, 15 of which must be from Laramie County Community College, with a grade point average of 2.0 or better at course level of 1000 or higher (ENGL 1001 does not apply).

University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U.

UW College of Arts and Sciences requirements:

Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's University Studies Program requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG). • No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation. • At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (the major may require more).

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For the BA in Art, all students are required to take Portfolio Review (ART 2000), a one-semester course in which work is created based on the content and principles learned in the foundation core classes. The course is offered every semester, including summer sessions online. If taken in the summer before starting at UW, a student could begin his or her upper division art studio requirements in the fall rather than the spring semester.

e) Art Studio Core Courses should be chosen from the following (at least one [1] course must be from two dimensional and one [1] from three dimensional, 12 hours total required):

Two Dimensional: ART 2005 (Drawing II), ART 2112 (Graphic Design), ART 2210 (Painting I), ART 2255 (Introduction to Photography, Digital), or ART 2265 (Introduction to Photography, Black and White), or ART 3510 (Printmaking).

Three Dimensional: ART 1310 (Introduction to Sculpture), ART 2350 (Metalsmithing), ART 2410 (Ceramics I), or ART 2420 (Ceramics II).

f) USP Communication 3. To be fulfilled with one of the following: ART 4010 (Contemporary Art: Theory and Practice), ART 4600 (Professional Practices & Strategies) or ART 4790 (Seminar).
