- Only one course from Science & Math Electives for the major may be taken Pass/Fail.
 No other Psychology courses for the major may be taken Pass/Fail! Pass/Fail grading is not encouraged.

b) While completing the Psychology major you will automatically earn the following:

Mathematics (M): BCC's MAT 224 = PSYC 243 Statistics (M) Laboratory (L): PSYC Lab (PSYC 352, 357, or 359)

c) Psychology majors could choose Psychology electives that also fulfill GenEd requirements:

Wellness (S): BCC's PSY 210 = PSYC 220 Developmental (S) or

BCC's PSY 214 = PSYC 223 Behavior Disorders (S)

Social Science (N): BCC's PSY 245 = PSYC 228 Social Psyc (N) or PSYC 406 Psycholinguistics (N)

d) GenEd Requirements not completed by the major: (take these before transferring)

Oral Communication (O), U.S. History & Pluralism (P), Global Interdependencies (G), Aesthetics (A) Humanities (H), Physical Activity (Y or B), Foreign Language requirement

- 2) Harpur Writing Requirements:

The writing requirement designations are:

C = Composition

J = Joint Oral Communication and Composition **Note: "J" classes count as "C" classes for this requirement.
