Elmira College and Arnot Ogden Medical Center School of Nursing Collaborative Agreement

The following is an agreement of understanding between the Elmira College Nurse Education Program and the Arnot Ogden Medical Center School of Nursing.

- 1. Students must successfully completing the Diploma of Nursing Program at Arnot Ogden Medical Center School of Nursing.
- 2. Students successfully completing the Diploma in Nursing, upon application will be admitted to the Elmira College Baccalaureate Program in Nursing through the Office of Admissions (full-time) or the Office of Continuing Education and Advanced Studies (part-time).
- 3. Students will be granted 20 credits through the National Program on Non-Collegiate Sponsored Instruction as the equivalent to NSG 2510, 2520, 3110, 2520, 3130, 3900. Additional NPONSI credits will be accepted as elective credit.
- 4. Students successfully completing the AOMC Nursing Program are eligible for the Transfer Honor Scholarship.
- 5. The AOMC School of Nursing will provide the students with information about this collaborative agreement.
- 6. The Director of the AOMC School of Nursing and the Director of the Nurse Education Program at Elmira College will establish and maintain liaison activities for distribution of information and effective advising of students.
- 7. This collaborative agreement will be reviewed for effectiveness in meeting the education needs of nursing students and mechanisms of program offerings as necessary.
