

(Renewed) Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Suffolk County Community College
and
Eastern Kentucky University
College of Justice & Safety

It is mutually agreed by Eastern Kentucky University, Richmond, Kentucky, and Suffolk County Community College, of Selden, New York, that the University will accept on a 2 + 2 basis (for "degree holders" if applicable), transfer credit from Suffolk County Community College as indicated on the attached equivalency schedule, incorporated herein by reference.

University will accept transfer of all course work listed on the attached equivalency schedule from Suffolk County Community College that meet the requirements, including grade, of the University's equivalent course into its applicable College of Justice and Safety programs. Other course work will be accepted as allowed under the applicable University undergraduate catalog. Specific credit will be allocated according to the core and/or specialization requirements, University requirements, College requirements and/or electives.

The allocation of advanced credit to the degree program will be the responsibility of the applicable Eastern Kentucky University program advisor subject to the approval of the Dean of the College of Justice & Safety.


Suffolk County Community College will retain full responsibility for the general education program of its students. Furthermore, the College should inform the University of changes in the curriculum or changes in the availability of learning opportunities as far in advance of the time change as feasible. Failure to do so may prevent articulation of the transfer credit.

The faculty and staff of both institutions are encouraged to visit each institution to plan, survey, observe, and/or participate in conferences with students and/or faculty.


An annual review of the program and curriculum referred to in this articulation agreement may be made by representatives from either institution.


This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party upon written notice to the other party six (6) calendar months prior to the desired effective date of termination.

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
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
