ENGLISH COMPOSITION	*6 credits = ENG 100; ENG112 <u>or</u> higher level.
QUANTITATIVE REASONING	*3 credits = MAT 100 <u>or</u> higher level.
FOREIGN LANGUAGE OR CULTURES	*6 credits = 2 Foreign Language (Introductory or higher level); <u>or</u> 2 Cultural Courses; <u>or</u> 1 Foreign Language and 1 Cultural Course.
THE ARTS	*3 credits = 1 Course in Art or an Art-related field, (i.e. Music; Web Page Design...).
INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES	* 3 credits = 1 Course which spans two subjects, (i.e. Women's History), plus SOC 210, SOC 240, SOC 180.
HUMANITIES	*12 credits = 4 Courses from 3 or more areas: (i.e. Literature; History; or Foreign Language/Culture, (SOC 210); Philosophy; or Religious Studies) (HUM 160)
SOCIAL SCIENCES	* 6 credits = 2 Courses from two areas: (i.e. Economics; Political Science; Psychology; or Sociology)
NATURAL SCIENCE with a LABORATORY	*4 credits = 1 Course in Biology; Physics; Chemistry; Environmental Science or other natural science with a laboratory
