

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
MERRIMACK COLLEGE  
AND  
NORTHERN ESSEX COMMUNITY COLLEGE

EFFECTIVE AS OF: May 5, 1988

The Merrimack College and Northern Essex Community College Articulation Agreement is an accord in which Merrimack College agrees to:

1. accept a number of Northern Essex Community College associate degrees meeting specific criteria as transfer degrees applicable in their entirety towards the fulfillment of the requirements of Merrimack College baccalaureate degrees in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and Civil and Electrical Engineering; and
2. admit Northern Essex students who have completed the accepted programs with a cumulative quality point average of at least 2.00 into Merrimack as juniors. Beyond a requirement that they must complete a minimum of full two years, or 20 courses and 60 credit hours, of additional coursework in order to qualify for Merrimack baccalaureate degrees, holders of the accepted transfer degrees are subject to no special requirements which "native" Merrimack students, students who have enrolled in Merrimack College as first semester freshmen, are not.
