TWO PLUS TWO AGREEMENT FOR ARTICULATION OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS Between BRISTOL COMMUNITY COLLEGE And THE MASSACHUSETTS COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS Spring 08

The above institutions hereby enter into an agreement to facilitate the transfer of students enrolled in the A.S. degree program in Leisure Service Management, Sports Management at Bristol Community College into the B.S. degree program in Business Administration, Events and Sports Management at The Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts.

OBJECTIVES OF THIS AGREEMENT

- 1. To attract qualified students to Bristol Community College and The Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts.
- 2. To promote and facilitate an efficient transition of transfer students from Bristol Community College into junior status in the B.S. degree program Business Administration, Events and Sports Management at The Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts with the opportunity for the students to complete the baccalaureate degree requirements within two years.
- 3. To provide specific information and guidelines for transfer students.
- 4. To encourage academic coordination and cooperation, including curricular reviews, on-site visitation and joint academic advising for students attending Bristol Community College.
- 5. To provide a framework for the exchange of information to monitor the success of this agreement.

STIPULATIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT:

- This agreement will apply to Bristol Community College transfer students who have completed a minimum of sixty- eight semester hours in the Associate of Science Leisure Service Management, Sports Management Degree Program while following the attached prescribed outline of courses for transfer credit.
- The Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts guarantees acceptance of Bristol Community College students who complete the Associate of Science Leisure Service Management, Sports Management Degree Program outlined in this document with an overall GPA of 2.5. All criteria of the Massachusetts Joint Admissions Program will apply.
- 3. Transfer students designated above will be accepted into junior status at The Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts.
- 4. It is understood that, as a general rule, students transferring from two-year colleges must complete a minimum of 60 credits, including at least half of the major for the baccalaureate degree.

MUTUAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Both institutions agree to maintain current listings of the course equivalencies. This will be the responsibility of the two designated representatives.

- 2. The Bristol Community College Director of Transfer Affairs will be responsible for assisting the transfer applicant in compiling the required credentials for application, which shall include the Intent to Enroll Form and college transcript.
- 3. Transfer applicants applying under this program shall be eligible for the same financial aid and housing consideration as other entering students.

ASSISTANCE PROVISIONS

- 1. Bristol Community College and The Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts will incorporate a summary of this agreement into official publications and web sites.
- 2. Bristol Community College and The Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts both agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this program by providing advising, information, and such other assistance required to assure that an easy transition from the two-year institution to the four-year institution will occur.

REVIEW/REVISION PROVISIONS:

1. Review of the contents or implementation of this agreement will occur whenever requested by either party through the designated representatives. Substantive changes in the courses or program of either institution will evoke review processes. Revisions must be mutually agreed upon, with one year notice prior to termination of the agreement.
